CONDITIONS APPLYING TO EXHIBITORS

APPLICATIONS AND PAYMENT

- 1. Applications and payment must be received by the Field Days Secretary no later than June 30, 2015.
- 2. All relevant forms must be completed with as much information as possible about the proposed exhibit. Applicants agree to promptly comply with all requests made by the Field Days Committee for additional information.
- 3. Exhibitors must hold Public Liability Insurance as cover against claims made by any person on their site. Please include a copy of the Certificate of Currency with your application.
- 4. Cancellations prior to July 31, 2015 will receive a full refund. Cancellations received after July 31, 2015 and before August 14, 2015 will receive a refund less \$100 for services rendered. Cancellations received after August 14, 2015 will not receive a refund.
- 5. Each application is subject to scrutiny by the Field Days Committee prior to acceptance. All applicants agree that their applications shall be considered by the Committee. The Committee shall be entitled, without being obliged to give reasons, to grant, refuse, or apply conditions to any application.
- 6. Failure by exhibitors to appear at the Field Days will be considered a breach of contract, and no refund of monies paid will be made.

EXHIBITOR DISPLAY TIMES DURING EVENT

- 7. Field Days site gates open at 6am (to exhibitors and public). Oval and Machinery displays close at 6pm.
- 8. Family Interest Pavilion doors open to exhibitors 7am and the public 8am. Display sites to close at 6pm. Pavilion doors close 6.30pm.

ARRIVAL TIMES

- 9. Static and comparative displays must be on the site by 5pm Tuesday of event week AND MUST NOT BE REMOVED before 4pm Thursday of event week. The Field Days are not open for trading at night but food and entertainment will be available.
- 10. Please note that late arrival of displays (after 5pm on Tuesday, September 1, 2015) will only be allowed by prior arrangement with the Secretary. Setting up of sites is not permitted between midnight and 6am.

DEPARTURE TIMES

- 11. It is a requirement that all exhibits and displays remain set up until 4pm on Thursday, September 3, 2015. Failure to do so may result in future applications being denied.
- 12. As a matter of safety, no vehicles are to be moved on the Field Days site before 4pm, unless authorised by the Field Days Committee. Gates will be closed to vehicles until this time.

- 13. All Oval exhibits to be removed by 4.30pm on Friday, September 4, 2015.
- 14. All Family Interest Display Pavilion exhibits to be removed by 12pm on Friday, September 4, 2015.

CAMPING

15. Camping is permitted on site from August 31. See page 7.

EVENT CANCELLATION

16. If the Field Days Committee should find it necessary or expedient to cancel or postpone the Field Days, contracts shall cease to operate upon notice to that effect and the Committee shall not be liable for any compensation or refund to exhibitors.

SITE SHARING

- 17. Exhibitors sharing a site must fill out an application form. This is to ensure that all exhibitors are included in the official program and that the location of every exhibitor is known to assist with visitor inquiries.
- 18. The Field Days Committee will not be held liable for loss or damage to the exhibitor's property while on the Field Days site.

MACHINERY MOVEMENT

- 19. Machines must be in the correct transport position when moving about the site and must not cut up the ground.
- 20. The movement of vehicles (including trials of small vehicles) is not permitted between 9.30am and 4.30pm on Wednesday and Thursday of event.

SITE CARE

- 21. Exhibitors shall be responsible for any damage to sites, water pipes, electricity cables or any other infrastructure. Spraying of grounds is not permitted without prior consent.
- 22. All plots must be left in reasonable condition prior to departure. Exhibitors are expected to co-operate in an effort to keep the display area clean.
- 23. Rubbish bags are available from the Field Days Office should exhibitors require them. All rubbish bags should be firmly secured before vacating your site.
- 24. All recyclables, including cardboard, can be folded and placed in a recycle skip bin located south of the Family Interest Display Pavilion or near Machinery Site 166.
- 25. Applications to erect permanent fixtures must be made to the Field Days Committee in writing.
- 26. Exhibitors must ensure all merchandise and marquee pegs remain within their site boundary. Marquee designs are all different and exhibitors need to request information regarding pegs on hired structures.



CONDITIONS APPLYING TO EXHIBITORS

POWER

- 27. The Field Days Committee is under no obligation to supply power to exhibitor sites. Power connections for exhibitor sites are to be ordered and paid for on the site application form. Late orders and payment will be accepted up to August 19, 2015 without penalty, however, orders made after this date will result in an additional fee of \$60 being incurred for connection. Please order the number of outlets to suit your appliance needs to eliminate overloading.
- 28. Extension cords and related items are not available from the Committee.
- 29. If ordered and paid for, power will be available to sites from Tuesday, September 1, 2015. Supply before this date cannot be guaranteed.
- 30. Generators are not permitted on exhibitor sites.
- 31. Urns, heaters and electric cooking equipment are discouraged due to power overload problems.

EXHIBITOR PASSES

- 32. Exhibitors are responsible for issuing passes to all personnel attending on their sites prior to the Field Days. The Field Days Committee requires all company personnel to be in possession of their passes to gain entry to the event, otherwise entry fee will be charged. It is a requirement of the Committee that exhibitors have read and comply with all conditions applying to exhibitors.
- 33. Refunds will not be given to exhibitors who fail to present passes at the gate. No pass means no entry. Please ensure that all passes are issued to attending personnel prior to their arrival on site.

CAR PASSES

- 34. Entry to vehicles on site will not be permitted without a car pass. Car passes must be displayed in vehicles at all times.
- 35. Movement of vehicles is not permitted on site between 9.30am and 4pm on the Wednesday and Thursday of event.
- 36. One vehicle per site is permitted to park on site if used as part of an exhibit. All other vehicles are to be moved to the exhibitor car parks, the locations of which are shown on the map on pages 10 and 11.

FOOD AND ALCOHOL ON SITE

- 37. All food vendors must meet local government health regulations and be able to provide on demand a Certificate of Currency for Public Liability.
- 38. Alcohol is not to be brought onto the grounds. Alcohol is available for purchase through Field Days facilities on site.
- 39. Barbecues are not permitted for cooking inside exhibitor marquees over the Field Days.

SUNDOWNERS

- 40. Machinery section exhibitors ONLY may hold sundowners between 4pm and 6pm. An Occasional Liquor Licence MUST be obtained to hold sundowners on the Field Days event site and a copy sent to the Field Days Secretary.
- 41. No alcohol is to be brought onto the grounds, other than that purchased through the Newdegate Hotel. An order form can be obtained by contacting the Newdegate Hotel on (08) 9871 1506. Alternatively, contact the Field Days Secretary.

ADVERTISING

- 42. Public address systems are not permitted, with the exception of the official broadcasting system provided by Adasound, located next to the Field Days Office. See page 21 to book public address system advertising during the Field Days.
- 43. Field Days exhibitors are not permitted to hand out advertising material or erect posters anywhere other than their own site.
- 44. Raffle tickets are not to be sold anywhere on the Field Days site without prior consent from the Field Days Committee.

BIOSECURITY

- 45. No grains, hay or seeds allowed on site. These can be ordered on application through the Field Days Office. This is a biosecurity issue and in the best interests of all exhibitors.
- 46. Biosecurity on the Field Days site is the responsibility of all exhibitors. All exhibitors are to be aware of any contamination risks with their displays and report them immediately to the Field Days Office.
- 47. Please dispose of rubbish in the correct manner. See 'Site Care' on page 4 for details. Exhibitors found to be ignoring these warnings will be asked to leave the Field Days.

LIVESTOCK WAYBILLS

48. Stock owners must meet their legal responsibilities for the identification and movement of their livestock before moving them to the event and provide organisers with a copy of completed waybill.




FAMILY INTEREST DISPLAY PAVILION MAP
